#### **Preparation:**

Sweep off loose dirt or light soiling. Remove coarse dirt thoroughly first.

### **Processing**

#### **Construction end cleaning:**

- 1. Dilute RZ 181 Elastic Wipe Care 1:10 with water
- Wet surface thoroughly and allow to act for a short time.
- **3.** Scrub lightly according to requirement or run over surface repeatedly with RZ Single-Disc Machine.
- 4. Collect slops

#### Maintenance cleaning:

- 1. Dilute RZ Elastic Wipe Care 1:200 with water
- **2.** Wet surface thoroughly and wipe with a synthetic fibre mop.
- **3.** Allow residual moisture to dry.

#### **Important Notes:**

- Stable in original container with storage under uniform conditions for an unlimited period.
- ► It is important to protect against frost or strongly fluctuating temperatures. Tightly close off containers already opened.
- Optimal processing at low air humidity (approx. 65%) and normal room temperatures (18 - 25 degrees centigrade).
- Regular maintenance care improves the optics and service life duration of the ex-works applied PU/PUR coating. Include these coatings in the maintenancecleaning only for so long until the first appearances of wear occur. Then, where appropriate, maintenance with RZ Elastic Sealer.
- ► Consider the RZ cleaning and maintenance instructions

#### Work and environment protection:

Non-flammable, no irritant effects and not environmentally dangerous. It is possible that the contained and designated components of the perfumes, as well as the preservatives, can cause sensitizing or allergies with certain groups of persons.
